**Christian Wholeness Framework** was developed in Australia in response to the need to integrate Christian theology and psychological research/practice for use as an assessment and formulation tool. It is valuable

- for its simplicity;
- for its use in the whole person approach to psycho/spiritual well being
- for its reproducibility

across all ages and cultures and across all types of lay or professional ministry.

It is now being used in Asia to train local churches to care more effectively as well as in managing mental health issues in professional settings.

We encourage all who care and who hold any positions in relationship with others ( which is all of us!) to explore this framework of understanding human bio-psycho-socio-spiritual function and transformation.

It is useful as a structure upon which all can build their work, To date, people in psychiatry, group counselling, parenting training, marital therapy, General practice, pastoral care and childrens work, as well as ministers and Christian workers in many fields, have used it.

**The program will be in 2 parts over the 4 days:**

1. Days 1 and 2 will be an introduction to the CWF and will have 2 streams —
  - a) for those who have commenced their training in Jan 2009 (this will be a refresher and will then stretch your understanding of and use of the framework.
  - b) for those who are new to the framework

(Some group work will be done together to see the value of the framework in various situations).

2. Days 3 and 4 will build on these 2 days, and will be used for case work, individual supervision and group supervision using the framework and is open to all who have attended in January 2009 or the first 2 days of this conference.

On these days, those attending will go deeply into the framework, which will allow for significant challenge in personal and work life.
